Technical reminder: The European Championship – Accuracy is to be held concurrently with the Skydiving World Cup Series (SWCS) round in the Czech Republic. Each competition is judged according to the respective rules, that differ from each other. The order of jumps in the individual rounds of the competition will be determined by the Meet Director according to the SWCS rules and Sporting Code SC5 5.2.2.2

#### 3.2. LOCATION OF THE EVENT

LKKT – Airfield Klatovy (Josef Hubáček airfield)  
K Letišti, 573, Chaloupky  
Klatovy, 339 01,  
Czech Republic

The town of Klatovy is located about 130 km SW from Prague, 245 km NE from Munich. The town inhabits approximately 23.000 people. Many supermarkets, restaurants and a hospital are within 5 min. drive from the airport. The Large Airfield is surrounded mostly by fields and grassy areas one of the safeties DZ. ### 4. TRANSPORTATION/ DETAILS OF ACCESS

The town of Klatovy is easily accessible by highway or by train. The organizer can help with arranging the train tickets and car rental.

Car access distances in hours:

Munich (International Airport MUC) - 2:20  
Berlin (International Airport BER) 4:43  
Vienna (International Airport (VIE) 4:26

Transportation for all officials (arrival point Prague / Pilsen) will be managed by organizer according to FCEAD 2.3 and bilateral agreement with the CJ based on individual needs/ arrival times for the judges.

Competitors are responsible for their own local transportation.

Late Entry Fee charge: plus 100€ / person (after deadline) must be paid in Euro.

Deadline for payment is 6th of June 2025 (6/6/2025).

The Sanction Fee is to be paid at a value in EUR that is no less than the conversion at the time of transfer, which is 105 CHF = 113 EUR at the time of publication.

**5.1. PAYMENT PROCEDURE**

Payment can be made within one week based on an invoice which will include bank details and will be sent together with the confirmation message after the final entry form signed by NAC authorised person has been submitted. The whole amount must reach the organiser's account with FAI Sanction fee included, as in section 5. Entry fee. Deadlines to avoid increased entry fee as in 5. section Entry fee. **5.2. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE**

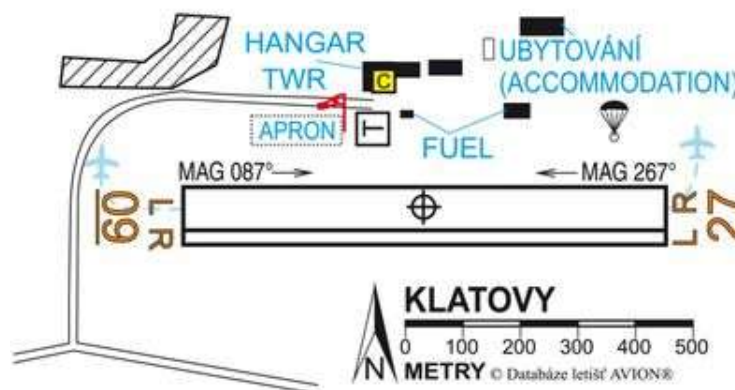

**6. DROPZONE**

Public domestic airport located 3,4 km NE of Klatovy (N 49° 25' 06" E 13° 19' 19")

ELEV: 1299 ft / 396m



The organizers chose the airport in Klatovy because it is one of the best equipped drop zones in the Czech Republic. Many foreigners from all over the world are expected to participate, and the drop zone and drop zone staff are well prepared and experienced.

## 7. AIRCRAFT

For Style (and accuracy training) multiple AN2 single engine bi-planes will be used.  
For Accuracy, helicopter AS 350 B3 Ecureuil (Heli-Austria) will be used.



## 8. PRE EVENT

Training is possible based on the dropzone price list <https://pink.at/prices> and operating hours.

## 9. ACCOMMODATION

It is possible to camp in your own tent or camper. The accommodation is fully covered by wi-fi and there are toilets and showers in sufficient capacity. Electricity sockets, waste disposal, and parking is available. It is possible to use the airport's accommodation capacity: 2-Bed Room: €22 per room per night, 10-Bed Dormitory: €8 per bed per night, Caravan (for 2 people): €18 per caravan per night, Hut container (for 2 people): €22 per container per night, Mobile House (for 4 people): €55 per mobile house per night (includes: kitchen, bathroom with shower and WC, 2 bedrooms, living room). Reservation is recommended at [manifest@pink.at](mailto:manifest@pink.at). There is large restaurant at the Klatovy drop zone serving good meals. Another smaller restaurant, intended mainly for competitors, allows breakfast and refreshments to be served during the competition. In all restaurants, as well as at the manifest, it is possible to pay by card and it is not necessary to use cash at all.

Directly at the Klatovy airport a swimming pool is available for all the competitors and their spouses.

In the city of Klatovy, as well as outside the city in the nearby area, there is a dense network of good quality accommodation facilities.

All participants are required to wear equipment which is in compliance with the FAI Competition rules effective 1 March, 2024. Reserve repack cycle is 365 days if not set shorter by manufacturer. AADs are required.

## 12. JUDGING EQUIPMENT

Airshots approved scoring system for Accuracy and Overall plus SkyCam and Style Score system will be provided by organizer.

## 13. IMMEDIATE MEDICAL CARE

Transportation to the hospital with helicopter in cases of serious injury or by ambulance depending on decision of the emergency services. The distance of nearest hospital is 3,3 km. The typical response time is 5 minutes.



#### 14. INSURANCE DETAILS

Individuals who are covered by their liability insurance valid in the CZE will not need to acquire liability insurance. Those who are not covered in the CZE will need to purchase a liability coverage valid for Czech Republic at the DZ.

Each competitor should be insured for injury with validity for Czech Republic and have valid third party liability insurance for skydiving activity.

The FAI Sporting Code 4.4.2 (4) requires that each delegation must bring its own national flag (approximately 100 cm x 150 cm) National anthems in MP3 format to be used in ceremonies, will be provided by the organiser, a representative of each participating NAC will be asked to check the anthem on registration.
